# *Summary*

- ★ Articles 5 7 8 deal with assessing how Annex 1 Parties are meeting their commitments –emissions limitation and reduction
- ★ In addition reporting on the following Articles:
  - 2.3 (Imp of P&M without adverse effects)
  - 3.2 (Demonstrable progress by 2005)
  - 10 (Advancing existing commitments under the Convention),
  - 11 (provision of financial resources to Developing Countries)



## *Summary Conts*

---

- ★ Decisions 19/CP7, 20/CP7, 22/CP7 and 23/CP7 are all relevant;
- ★ Implementation involves:
  - Setting up national systems comprising the institutional arrangements for producing inventories
  - Choices (on the base year, F-gas and LULUCF activities) that will be in place to for **accounting assigned amounts**;





## 6 Issues relating to **registries under Art 7.4 of the KP**

Decision 19/CP.7 –development of technical standards for the purposes of **ensuring the accurate, transparent and efficient exchange of data between national registries, the CDM registry and the transaction log**
